**Brief Description:** The project enables activities under the expedited procedures to assist Macedonia in addressing the priority capacity needs in the climate change area, as an interim measure between the preparation of the First National Communication and the Second National Communication. The components of the project are: a) Technology Transfer: Identification/submission of technology needs; Capacity building to assess technology needs, modalities to acquire and absorb technologies, design, evaluate and host projects; b) Capacity building for participation in systematic observation networks. Beside capacity building, the project is expected to increase public awareness and knowledge on the GHG abatement potentials in the country, and to strengthen the dialogue and information exchange between relevant stakeholders, including policy makers, academic sector, private sector and NGO.
